

Kids Kamp 2021

Guidelines and procedures during Covid19 Pandemic (updated Feb 1, 2021 – subject to change per CDC, DCFS, IDPH guidelines)

1. Groups of 10-20 campers with teacher and counselor.
2. Each group will have their own building entrance to be determined by start of camp. Only campers and staff are allowed in the building, so drop off and pick up is at the building entrance.
3. **Temperature checks will be done at arrival (camper and staff). Any individual with a temperature of 100.4 degrees or above will not be able to stay. Individual can return after 72 hours (fever free without medication.) Any enrolled family must also report any COVID 19 exposure/diagnosis which may lead to mandated quarantine or possible closure of camp for 2 weeks.**
4. Staff and campers wear a mask at all times inside the building. Masks can be removed when eating or during certain outside activities. Parents are responsible for providing a mask for their child, labeled with name.
5. Each camper will have their own bin of art supplies in order to limit the sharing of materials. There is a one time fee of \$10 for the art supplies **or** parents can provide the art supplies from the list provided by the teacher.
6. Playground use is one group at a time with disinfecting equipment in between groups.
7. Snack will be individually prepackaged and provided by CLC.
8. Campers staying for afternoon activities are allowed to bring lunch from home. Food must be single use in disposable containers. No microwave is available but there is refrigerator space if needed.
9. There will be enhanced cleaning/disinfecting throughout the building before, during and after each camp day.
10. The drinking fountain will not be available. Campers need to bring a water bottle from home. Staff will refill water bottles when necessary.
11. Camper must be able to use the bathroom independently. Single use gloves will be used if a staff member needs to help a camper with a toilet accident. Staff will supervise all handwashing in the bathroom.
12. Hand sanitizing stations will be set up in classrooms and hallways.

I have read and will follow all the guidelines listed above to help keep all participants in CLC Kids Kamp healthy during the COVID19 pandemic.
